Courses Offered

FRIDAY NIGHT CLASS:

Landing Zone Class: 6:00pm-8:30pm. A landing zone class will be held by STAT Medevac discussing LZ safety & operations. Weather permitting, STAT will bring in a helicopter to see up close and meet the medical crew & pilot. This class will be held Friday night and is open to all. There is no fee to attend this class.

SATURDAY & SUNDAY CLASSES:

Farm Medic: Classroom presentation & familiarity with agricultural operations; practical skills evolutions and a "walk-around" of nearby farming operation to familiarize students with farms/farming operations.

Prerequisites: NONE

Appropriate PPE & basic familiarity of extrication tools & techniques.

Minimum students required: 20 Max: 40

FF1 Refresher: This class will consist of multiple mini classes that will include Gas meters, Thermal Imaging Cameras, I Am Responding, Learning Management System and Radios.

Must sign up with LMS AND the registration attached. This is a NYS class.

Prerequisites: BEFO/Scene Support or equivalent

Minimum students required: 10 Max: 24

Fire Alarm & Sprinkler System: An overview of the components, operations & design of fire alarm systems. An overview of wet, dry, deluge, preaction & residential sprinkler systems; water supply & design of sprinkler systems.

Must sign up with LMS AND the registration attached. This is a NYS class.

Prerequisites: NONE

Minimum students required: 10 Max: 24

STAT MEDEVAC Search and Rescue: STAT Medevac will be partnering with Chautauqua County Technical Rescue Team and Chautauqua County Search and Rescue Team to teach basic landing zone safety and operations, basic search skills, basic wilderness survival and basic rescue techniques.

Prerequisites: NONE. This class is open to all.

Appropriate clothing as this is an indoor/outdoor class.
No minimum/max students required.

EMS Track: Allegheny Health Network will provide classes on Saturday with multiple instructors. Topics TBA
UPMC will provide Simulation scenarios in the back of an ambulance, a lecture on “THE BIG THREE: Cardiac/Neuro/Trauma, and an airway lab using pig lungs. UPMC’s classes will be held on Sunday.

SUNDAY at 1PM we will have a Corn Hole Tournament and a Water Battle. This is open to any fire service member even if you did not attend the training weekend. Please choose which one you would like to be part of. Make sure your partner is from the same department as you. Please make sure you fill out a registration form and return to Chautauqua County Weekend so we know you plan to participate.

- *All participants will receive a certificate and all EMS classes will be CME credits for both NY & PA.
- **Once registrations & payments have been made, a “letter of acceptance” will go out to each student with further information.
- ***The cost of this weekend will be \$100.00 per person. If you would like to camp at the campgrounds, the fee is \$30.00 for a camper per night and \$20.00 for a tent per night. For more information and reservations call 716-595-3776.

Chiefs Authorization Letter

1. General Instructions
 - A. The student firefighter or department shall submit with their application(s) a completed Training Authorization Letter (updated version from 4-15-18) **signed by a chief officer and the individual student** for the registration to be accepted.
 - B. Any student registration that does not have a completed Chiefs Authorization Letter will not be considered.
 - C. A Training Authorization Letter must be submitted for each student.
 - D. Those students enrolling in a course requiring SCBA must have the Medical Clearance section completed. These students must have a current SCBA approval physical on file at their department.
2. Course Attendance by 16 and 17 Year Old Firefighters:
 - A. Student firefighters 16 or 17 years of age must be members of a Fire Company, Department or District. They must complete a Training Authorization Letter. This letter must be signed by a chief officer, the student firefighter and parent or legal guardian and submitted at registration for the first session of any course offered by OFPC.
 - B. Any 16 or 17 year-old student firefighter that does not submit a signed letter will not participate in the course.
 - C. Explorers that are not actual members of the Fire Dept., Company or District will not be allowed to Participate.
