Course Description:

This is the first course in the Fire Officer series, addressing the job performance requirements of Chapter 4 of NFPA 1021, *Standard for Fire Officer Professional Qualifications*. This course includes topics such as the company officer's duties and responsibilities, leadership and supervision, human resources management, communications, administrative functions, and health and safety issues. Also included in this course are topics including company level training, community relations, pre-incident surveys, and the delivery of emergency services. Students completing this course will also receive a certificate of completion for the Fireground Strategy and Tactics for First Arriving Companies course, which is included in its entirety as part of this course. The Fireground Strategy and Tactics for First Arriving Companies course is a new strategy and tactics course that focuses on scene size-up, engine company operations, truck company operations, as well as non-fire emergencies.

Prerequisites: SCBA / IFO; Firefighter I; Basic and Intermediate FF and HMFRO and either FF Survival or Mask Confidence; FF Essentials and Initial Fire Attack I and HMFRO and either FF Survival or Mask Confidence
