This is a challenge refresher course. You can challenge the course if you are a current EMT (within 9 months of expiration) or have been an EMT (any expired NYS EMT, regardless of when they expired). **There will be a written examination on 9/17/18 to determine which classes you MUST attend.**

**There will be a mandatory "Challenge Practical Skills Exam" on 9/19/18.**

The student will be expected to attend all MANDATORY SESSIONS along with a CPR session. Failure to attend these sessions will prevent the student from taking the State written examination. **The student must produce ICS100/700 certificate and HAZMAT Awareness OSHA 1910 Compliance. If the student does not complete ICS 100/700 and HazMat they will not be eligible to take the NYS Written Exam.**

The course is NYS Department of Health certified. The NYS Written Exam will be given on 11/15/18.
